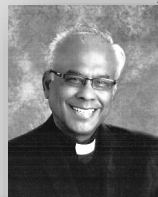
Welcome:

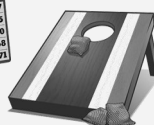

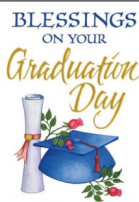
