

National Eucharistic Procession ~ Talking Points from the Pulpit

Eucharistic Procession: All are Welcome

1. Begins at 2:00PM at the Park 'n Ride south of Kwik Trip and Draxler's Transportation
2. Proceeds down Veteran's Pkwy via the Bike Trail
3. Four Altar Stops: Counter Form, Hume across from the Water Tower, Hansen-Schilling Funeral Home, POW/MIA War Memorial
4. Concludes at St. John the Baptist Church with Benediction
5. Walk a Half-Mile or More with Jesus
 - a. Total Distance: 4.1 Miles
 - b. Join at an Altar Stop along the Procession route if wish to walk a shorter distance or according to your availability after work, etc.

Transportation for Procession Participants

1. Please park your vehicle at St. John the Baptist (North Parking Lot or Street)
2. Shuttle Vehicles will provide transportation to the Park 'n Ride AND to each of the Altar Stops. Feel free to JOIN the Procession at any time.
3. Shuttle Vehicles will be parked at SJB Rectory garage. All shuttle vehicles will have a "Shuttle / Eucharistic Procession" sign on them.
4. Exception: Shuttle vehicles are not equipped to transport children who require a car seat or booster seat. We recommend that you transport your child/adult to the Altar Stop, return to SJB to park your car and return via the Shuttle vehicle.
5. Why Park at SJB: Your vehicle will be immediately available to you at the conclusion of the Eucharistic Procession. Shuttle drivers are not expected to spend a lengthy period of time transporting procession participants back to their vehicles at the conclusion of the procession. Park 'n Ride has limited parking spots available / safety for procession participants by avoiding "traffic" in this area.

Post Eucharistic Procession Activities

1. Pot Luck Supper in Schuh Hall (SJB School)
 - a. Before joining in the Procession, please bring a Dish to Pass to SJB School (front entrance off of Blodgett Street). Volunteers will begin receiving food at 1:00PM
2. Eucharistic Miracles of the World Exhibit – SJB School: Open 4:30PM – 6:00PM / 8:00PM-9:00PM
3. Diocese of La Crosse Mission Activities – SJB School, i.e., Casa Hogar, Chalice of Mercy, etc. will have displays about their work in the Diocese. Open 4:30PM – 6:00PM / 8:00PM-9:00PM
4. Presentations – SJB Church
 - a. Blessed Brother James Miller – Fr. Alan: 6:00PM – 6:50PM
 - b. Servant of God Fr. Joseph Walijewski – Fr. Sebastian: 7:00PM – 7:50PM
5. Eucharistic Adoration moves from St. John Paul II Adoration Chapel to SJB Church
 - a. Monday, June 10 @ 8:00PM – Tuesday, June 11 @ 7:00AM
 - b. All are Welcome at any time throughout the night
6. Matins with Fr. Robert Thorn
 - a. 3:00AM – 4:00AM Prayers for Miracle Healings offered through the intercession of Fr. Joseph Walijewsk
7. Mass at 7:00AM – SJB
